Club Championship Shoot

Just a reminder that next month is the Club Championship (last Saturday of the month). The event is a Handicap Canberra. You will need to have shot at 3 club shoots to have a handicap. Archers who do not have a handicap are ineligible to compete for the Club Championship but are still welcome to shoot on the day.

Competition starts at 1:30pm promptly.

Club Christmas Shoot

A reminder that the Christmas shoot will be on the 20th of December. As with past years it is teams event - teams of two - with a ranking round followed by matchplay. The scoring is a hit-or-miss system with archers being handicapped by their bow type plus or minus a bit for the beginners or experts.

Next Trad Shoot

The second Saturday of November there will be a friendly Trad shoot. (Barebow and Wood Arrows with Feathers.)

The round will be either a Drake (90 arrows, 80cm target, 30 metres) or a Newcastle (90 arrows, 122cm target, 20metres) or a Geelong (90 arrows, 122cm target, 30m) depending on who is shooting. We have a new junior who is using a Longbow so perhaps a split round is the order of the day.
